**Fable, parable, and allegory—Historical development in**

Shifts from naive to sophisticated intent are accompanied by shifts in form. The early authors of fable, following Aesop, wrote in verse; but in the 10th century there appeared collected fables, entitled Romulus, written in prose (and books such as this brought down into the medieval and modern era a rich tradition of prose fables). This collection in turn was converted back into elegiac verse.

Fables and Parables A fable is a brief story intended to teach a moral lesson. The main characters are usually animals, objects in nature (e.g. mountains, lakes, stones) or forces of nature (e.g. the sun, the wind, the rain), which are given human qualities. The most famous fables in Western tradition are Aesop's fables from Ancient Greece. There are also many well-known fables from China, India and other Asian cultures.

**3 Timeless Parables For Requiring Perspective**

Fable, parable, and allegory, any form of imaginative literature or spoken utterance constructed in such a way that readers or listeners are encouraged to look for meanings hidden beneath the literal surface of the fiction. A story is told or perhaps enacted whose details—when interpreted—are found to correspond to the details of some other system of relations (its hidden, allegorical sense).

Fables and parables do differ in a couple of specifics, however. The main difference between the two is that fables always use non-human characters to teach their lessons, while parables are always about people. Fables are set in a fantasy world ("fabulous" having the same root word as "fable"), and parables are much more rooted in reality.
